- Report abuse or misconduct of any kind.
- Inform us if you are ill or feeling overwhelmed and cannot shop for yourself. A pantry volunteer can pack your food while you wait on the porch or in your vehicle.

By signing, I understand that if I choose not to abide by these values, I will be asked to wait off property and a pantry volunteer will shop for me.
